” Kvinder og deres oliventræer”

Et bevægende udtryk for tolerance, venskab og kærlighed.

I 2013 mødtes 35 muslimske, kristne og jødiske kvinder for første gang i WIZOs borgercenter i Afula, Israel for at finde ud af, om de ved at male sammen på ugentlig basis kunne nå frem til at leve i fredelig sameksistens med hinanden. Resultatet af deres initiativ er, at de har fået nedbrudt nogle fordomme om hinanden, og selv i svære stunder har de formået at fortsætte samværet. Ved at udstille deres malerier af fredssymbolet, oliventræet, ønsker de at vise, at hvis viljen er der, er det muligt at respektere sine naboer på trods af forskellige religiøse og kulturelle tilhørsforhold. Kvinderne ønsker at inspirere andre til at gøre det samme i håbet om, at verden kan blive et fredeligere sted, bl.a. ved at politikere tør lade sig overbevise og herefter træffe beslutninger, der kan danne grundlag herfor.

WIZO Danmark ønsker at vise danskerne denne udstilling. Dels for at inspirere danskerne til at gå ind i nogle sammenhænge på tværs af kultur og religion, dels for at vise, at der i et af de mest omtalte brændpunkter i verden, Israel, findes aktive fredsinitiativer blandt befolkningen. Det giver os et håb for en bedre fremtid, og WIZO Danmark ønsker at støtte sådanne initiativer.

”Women and their Olive Trees”

A moving expression of tolerance, friendship and love.

35 Israeli Muslim, Christian and Jewish women met in WIZO Community Center in Afula for the first time in 2013 to find out whether they could work together for peaceful coexistence. Since then they have met once a week to paint and talk together. The result of their initiative is that they have broken down some prejudices about each other, and even in difficult times managed to continue to meet. By exhibiting their paintings of the peace symbol, the Olive Tree, they want to show that if the will is there, it is possible to respect one's neighbours in spite of different religious and cultural differences. The women want to inspire others to do the same with the purpose of making the world a more peaceful place.

WIZO Denmark would like to show this exhibition to the Danes. The objective is to inspire the Danes to build some contexts across different cultures by focusing on all the things that connects, contributes and enriches one another instead of what is separating them, and also to show that in one of the most famous focal points in the world, Israel, there are active peace initiatives among the population of cultural, religious and political contrasts. This gives us hope for a better future, and WIZO Denmark wants to show their support to such wonderful initiatives.
